

## TASO Point System, as of 2008 Football Season

Points will be awarded in two categories – **Games** and **Education** (which includes Annual Test)

### Games

- Varsity (including college) **2 points per game**, max of 30 points per year
- Non Varsity (Assigned by the Chapter) **½ points per game**, no maximum
- Chains and Timers **½ points per game**, no maximum
- Scrimmages (including college) **1 point each**, max of 3 per year

### Education – Max of 20 points (exception: see NOTE below)

- State Meeting 6 points
- Regional Rules Clinics/Workshops 3 points
- District meeting 2 points
- Annual Test Scores
  - 70-79 2 points
  - 80-89 4 points
  - 90-100 8 points

**NOTE:** If you attended the 2008 State Meeting in Abilene, **AND** you were in Division 3, 4 or 5 at the beginning of the 2008 season, you can claim an additional 18 points.

### Annual Requirements – if not met, no varsity games will be assigned

- 1 rules clinic each year
- Annual test, with a minimum score of 70

### Division Breakout, by points accrued – determined at beginning of the season

Division 5	0 points
Division 4	60 points
Division 3	180 points
Division 2	360 points + 40 varsity games
Division 1	660 points + 75 varsity games

### FAQ's

- Is there credit for college chains?  
Yes – ½ point
- Is there credit for college scrimmages?  
Yes – 1 per scrimmage, but they count with the high school ones, max of 3 per year
- Is there credit for the district meetings held each year?  
Yes – 2 points, if a Rules session is given
